## Huge savings upfront

# How does Reposit work?



## Choose.

Ask your agent or landlord for Reposit instead of a standard cash deposit.



## Sign up & Pay.

You will receive an email to sign up and pay the Reposit fee on our platform.



## Move in.

Enjoy living deposit-free in your new home!



## Check out.

No waiting for your deposit back! Easily settle any amounts due, or raise a dispute via Reposit.

## How much will I pay?

### Fee

Reposit fee

### Amount

1 week's rent\*

### When?

At the start of the tenancy, split between all tenants.

Annual fee

£30

Every 12 months of the tenancy, split between all tenants.

## Moving in together?

Split the Reposit fee between all tenants – a great option for groups!



### The legal bit.

The Reposit fee is **non-refundable** and cannot be offset against costs at the end of tenancy.

Just like with a normal deposit, **you remain liable for any outstanding amounts** due to the landlord at the end of your tenancy (e.g. cleaning fees, costs for repairs, outstanding rent), but with Reposit you only pay if they actually occur, rather than paying upfront.

In case of a dispute you will be charged £60 which will be refunded to you if your dispute is successful.



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
